CALLING PROCEDURES

Immediate danger for persons
or ship. eg. sinking

PAN-PAN

Urgent message concerning
safety of a person or ship
eg. medical emergency

- Give vessel name and call sign
- State position of vessel
- Describe nature of emergency

EMERGENCY
POSITION INDICATING
RADIOBEACON
(EPIRB)

- USE TYPE 406 MHz



BEFORE LEAVING THE DOCK

- TELL A FRIEND,
OR HARBOUR RADIO
- ENSURE REQUIRED SAFETY

- CHECK WEATHER FORECAST
- CHECK BOAT/FUEL/BATTERY
